

The Niagara County Youth Bureau/Out of School Youth program works with 17-21 year old youths that meet the 200% poverty level. Some of these youth need their GED, some need a job while others need assistance with college applications and financial aid forms. Referrals to local agencies for GED classes, obtaining food, or a birth certificate from out of town, or paying for college entrance testing are just examples of what we do. Whatever the needs, the Youth Bureau provides intensive case management so that each youth has a chance to reach his or her full potential. We also provide assistance to youth that aren't in our program with referrals to VESID, assistance with FAFSA forms and referrals to GED classes.
